 - The abstract as a whole should be correctly formatted and have the different sub-sections clearly: Background; Methods, Results, and Conclusions and recommendations. These are missing.
 - In the methods section the following information should be included/clarified: How many participants were included? Who were the data collectors? Where did the data collection take place? Were their efforts to triangulate the participants/methods to enhance credibility and trustworthiness of the findings being a qualitative research design? Were community members who benefited from the community led interventions included as participants? How many focus group discussions case studies, and in-depth interviews were conducted as part of the data collection process? Did you audio record your conversations? And how was the qualitative data synthesized and analyzed which framework did you use? Did you use a formal analysis tool e.g. NVivo to manage your qualitative nodes?
